1. Computer Science Furniture Replacement – Heather Wolfe

- a. Furniture in lounge and common areas in need of replacement
 - i. Furniture in first floor lounge, second, and third floor common areas
 - ii. Has been in use since building was constructed ten years ago
 - iii. Common areas have much more academic use than the first-floor lounge
- b. Proposed new furniture chosen by looking at what is best from around campus
 - i. Using vinyl as opposed to the cloth
 - ii. Easier to clean and more durable—UV protection important with large windows
 - iii. Use of company that sustainably builds furniture
 - iv. Furniture comes with long-term warranty—hoping to last at least 15 years
 - v. No increase in total seating
- c. Replacement of lab chairs-Lab 110
 - i. Used for labs and tutoring
 - ii. Current chairs have similar wear and tear damage
- d. Building is often used by individuals visiting the university

- i. Undergrads from other universities, visiting students, visiting faculty
- e. Partial funding would be accepted, but not preferred
 - i. Student input important to determine which pieces would be funded
- f. Vote of Legitimacy- In Favor-10 Opposed-0, Project is legitimized
- 2. Behavioral Sciences Building Furniture Revitalization Ginger Lacy-Gill
 - a. BSB completed in 2010, furniture in use since then
 - i. Furniture is damaged and very dirty—side tables and chairs
 - ii. No good way to sanitize the furniture
 - b. Building often used by students from all colleges, open to students 24 hours a day
 - i. 10 study rooms controlled by library, general assignment classrooms, open study areas
 - c. Furniture is limited
 - i. Students often exceed number of seats available
 - d. Prospective students are brought through BSB often
 - e. New furniture-asking for 200 new pieces
 - i. More durable and easy to clean—vinyl material
 - ii. Fits more aesthetically with the building
 - iii. Working with same sustainable company as Computer Science
 - iv. Want to get something comfortable to work on and easy to move—more single chairs and less large couches
 - v. Make more seating available overall
 - f. First floor is priority
 - i. Much more student use than other floors
 - g. Vote of Legitimacy- In Favor-11 Opposed-0, Project is legitimized
